**We hereby inform you that** according to art. 15 et seq. GDPR you have the right to obtain the **confirmation** as to whether or not your personal data are being processed. Further, you have the right to obtain the **rectification** of inaccurate personal data as well as the right of **erasure** or the **restriction**

of processing your personal data. You also have the **right of withdrawal** the processing of your personal data and to **data portability**.

According to art. 77 GDPR you also have the right to lodge a **complaint** with a supervisory authority if you consider the processing of your personal data as violating the regulation.

If the processing is based on art. 6 (1) lit. a GDPR or art. 9 (2) lit. a GDPR (**consent**), you also have the right to object the consent **at any time** without affecting the legality of the processing based on the valid consent until the objection.
